Our Parish...

Here at Prince of Peace, everything we do is guided by a single mission: to give praise and glory to our Lord, Jesus Christ. He has blessed us in many ways, and we strive to share those blessings not only with our parish family but also with our brothers and sisters in the larger community.

Through our social services ministry, God, in His infinite grace, has granted our parish a very special charism – a Greek term denoting any good gift that flows from God’s benevolent love. For many years we have been deeply involved with the Family Renew Community, which assists homeless families with transitional housing, and Prince of Peace Villas, which offers affordable apartments for low income senior citizens. And this year we are blessed to celebrate the 25th anniversary of our food pantry.

These works are a demonstration of how we live our love for Jesus Christ, in response to His own words to us: *For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, a stranger and you welcomed me, naked and you clothed me, ill and you cared for me, in prison and you visited me* (Matthew 25: 35-36).

In looking to the future, we want to maintain these vital commitments while remaining open to new possibilities for service and outreach. The *Alive in Christ* Capital Campaign is designed to help fund the growing needs of our diocese while providing support for the long-held dreams of our own parish. *Alive in Christ* will ensure that we have the resources necessary to continue caring for the poor, the downtrodden, and the needy.

Please reflect on the information in this brochure and prayerfully consider how you might help our parish to further Christ’s Kingdom in the world.

Our Need...

Through *Alive in Christ* we have a profound opportunity to **Grow**, **Lead** and **Share** our living faith by addressing our most critical parish needs.

We **GROW** in the love of Christ through time spent before His Real Presence in the Eucharist. Our families have expressed a deep desire for Perpetual Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, but we currently lack an appropriate location for uninterrupted, quiet prayer. **Our parish needs a simple, beautiful, quiet space that is suitable for this intimate devotion.**



Our parish ministries help us to **LEAD** one another to a deeper relationship with Christ, so that we might go out into the world and **LEAD** others to Christ. Our Religious Education programs – for both children and adults – are alive and growing, and we continue to add new ministries that enrich our understanding of the Catholic faith. **We are now facing a shortage of meeting space and our current facilities are no longer adequate to support these new opportunities.** It is essential that we increase our available space rather than decrease these vibrant parish ministries.

Through our social services we assist over a thousand people every month. This is largely funded from the proceeds of our “Like New [thrift] Shop.” **The current economy has greatly intensified the need for help, but our social service**

ministry is limited by inadequate space. There is insufficient storage space in our food pantry, and our classrooms must substitute as food storage units. The “Like New Shop” is also struggling with space limitations and is frequently forced to turn away donations. Uniting these efforts in one larger facility will help us to **SHARE** the love and compassion of Christ more effectively.



Our Plan...

In response to our Lord's call, we seek to:

Build a New Social Services Ministry Center

Our new facility will house:

- An Adoration Chapel
 - A sacred space for intimate prayer
 - A source of spiritual growth for our parish
- General Meeting Room
 - Ample meeting space for our Religious Education programs
 - Private setting for our new ministry: Christ Renews His Parish
- Outreach Ministries to the Poor, including:
 - Social services offices
 - Considerably larger food pantry to meet the needs of this "in demand" ministry
 - Thrift store double the size of the space we are currently renting for approximately \$3,300 per month

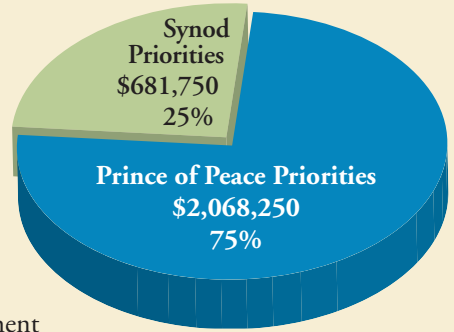


Our food pantry provides food, toiletries and other basic necessities to over 1000 needy people every month.

Our Goal...

Our *Alive in Christ* Campaign Goal is \$2,750,000.

If we are blessed to raise this amount, *more than \$2 million will stay with our parish to fund our new building.* As members of the Universal Church, we will contribute the remaining \$681,750 to our larger Church family to help fund the many new projects taking place throughout the nine counties of our Diocese.



Alive in Christ provides an important moment in the life of our parish family and in the larger diocesan family to which we belong. Guided by the Holy Spirit, *Alive in Christ* is an important step in building a strong and vital Church for the future.

Our Diocese...

This is an exciting time for the Diocese of Orlando. Our ministry reaches back over 40 years, and we have much to celebrate. We are blessed with people of faith and vision – people who embrace and celebrate Catholic truth, transform communities and make known the love of Christ throughout Central Florida.

We are also blessed with a rapidly growing and increasingly diverse population, allowing the Gospel message to reach more people in more ways than ever before. With this extraordinary growth come new challenges and new opportunities.

Throughout the 18-month synod planning process, more than 1,000 of Christ's faithful, both lay and clergy, gathered together to explore opportunities and to define a bold new vision for the Diocese of Orlando.

Central to this vision is a renewed commitment to **GROW, LEAD and SHARE** the living faith that we have received from the Apostles and those who have gone before us. *Alive in Christ* will enable the Diocese of Orlando to live up to these commitments in a way that will transform our Church and our communities for generations to come.

In Central Florida, our Church is Alive!

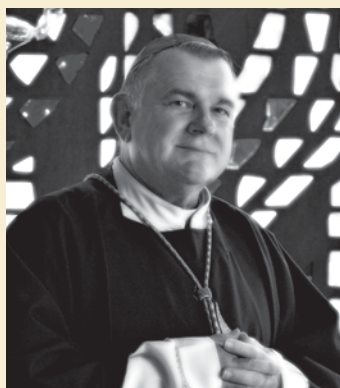
Called to Grow, Lead and Share...

Ways to Give...

Making a Pledge

Pledge payments can be scheduled at the discretion of the donor, to be paid on a monthly, quarterly, or yearly basis beginning at any time, throughout a 3-5 year period. All pledges, outright gifts of capital, Charitable Gift Annuities, Charitable Lead Trusts and other irrevocable planned gifts made to *Alive in Christ*, from the Fall of 2007 through the end of the campaign, will be counted in the final campaign total.



Gifts of Securities

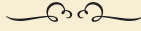
It is the policy of the Diocese of Orlando to sell all securities upon receipt to minimize the chances of having adverse market fluctuations affect the beneficial interest of your gift. Gifts in kind – real estate, insurance, closely held stock, art, and other tangibles – may be counted if they are sold and the proceeds revert to the diocese.

Bequests, Charitable Remainder Trusts, and Revocable Planned Gifts

While we will commemorate and record bequests, Charitable Remainder Trusts and other revocable planned gifts made to the diocese, they cannot be included in the campaign total precisely because of their revocable nature. Unrestricted bequests received during the course of the campaign may be counted towards the campaign at the diocese's discretion.

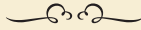
