## Our Parish...

### History

Our story began in 1980, when three ladies began a crusade to bring the eucharist to the growing community of Astor. On November 28, 1982, forty-five of Christ's faithful gathered to celebrate the first Mass, held at the Astor Community Center. Through the grace of God and the faithfulness of His people, the dream of a permanent Catholic community was realized in December 1985, when Bishop Thomas Grady gave permission to establish St. Hubert of the Forest Mission. Prayer and hard work led to the construction of a multipurpose worship space and the celebration of our first Mass as a community.

We have much to celebrate as a community of faith. Our young mission has grown from the initial 32 families to 119 registered families. We are committed to lives of stewardship and service in the Lord's name. And our community is debt-free, thanks to God's abundant blessings and the tremendous generosity of our families.

The economic situation is affecting all of us, and many families are experiencing unprecedented hardship. We were blessed to celebrate our first Mass on Christmas Eve – a time of great joy and promise. In the midst of darkness, the light of Christ penetrates our world and transforms our lives. ## *Our Need...*

The Lord is calling us to Grow, Lead, and Share our living faith. Here at St. Hubert of the Forest Mission, we want to answer that call by addressing our most critical parish needs:



Our parishioners currently park in a dirt lot, which creates unsafe conditions during inclement weather. During the rainy season, the mud is hazardous for drivers and makes walking difficult for many of our parishioners. We need to pave our parking area so that we might continue to **GROW** our faith community.

Through our religious education programs, we form our young people as faithful disciples and prepare them to **LEAD** others to a new life in Christ. Due to space limitations, our multipurpose building must function as a church, gathering area, and classroom. This arrangement places a strain on all of our ministries, including religious education. The addition of two new classrooms would provide much-needed space and would encourage the formation of additional church groups.

We **SHARE** God's love as we reach out to others through our parish ministries. We are in need of a covered outdoor facility that will provide a gathering space for our church groups and a cooking area for our annual fish fry.



## *Our Plan...*

Addressing our critical needs will ensure that St. Hubert of the Forest Mission is well prepared to face the challenges of the 21st century while continuing to meet the spiritual, educational, and pastoral needs of God's people. Through *Alive in Christ* we will:

### **Pave our Parking Area**

- A paved parking lot will be safer and more accessible for our parishioners and for those who will join us in the coming years.

### **Construct Two New Classrooms**

- The addition of two classrooms will provide much-needed space for the spiritual development of our students.

### **Construct a Covered Outdoor Facility**

- The construction of a simple pole barn will offer a covered outdoor facility for our church groups and create new opportunities for fellowship and ministry.

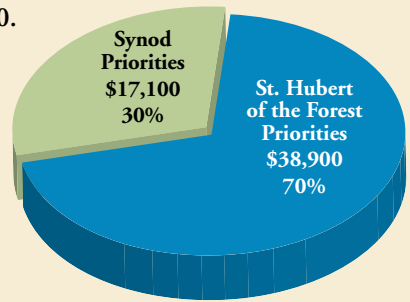

## Our Goal...

Our *Alive in Christ* Campaign Goal is \$56,000.

If we are blessed to reach our goal, **\$38,900**, or 70%, *will be used to fund our most urgent priorities*. We will share the remaining \$17,100 with our larger Church family to help fund the bold and exciting new projects taking place throughout the nine counties of our diocese.



*Alive in Christ* provides an important moment in the life of our parish family and in the larger diocesan family to which we belong. Guided by the Holy Spirit, *Alive in Christ* is an important step in building a strong and vital Church for the future.

## Our Diocese...

This is an exciting time for the Diocese of Orlando. Last year marked our 40th year of mission and ministry, and we have much to celebrate. ## Ways to Give...

### Making a Pledge

Pledge payments can be scheduled at the discretion of the donor, to be paid on a monthly, quarterly, or yearly basis beginning at any time, throughout a 3-5 year period. All pledges, outright gifts of capital, Charitable Gift Annuities, Charitable Lead Trusts and other irrevocable planned gifts made to *Alive in Christ*, from the Fall of 2007 through the end of the Campaign, will be counted in the final Campaign total.



### Gifts of Securities

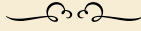
It is the policy of the Diocese of Orlando to sell all securities upon receipt to minimize the chances of having adverse market fluctuations affect the beneficial interest of your gift. Gifts in kind—real estate, insurance, closely held stock, art, and other tangibles—may be counted if they are sold and the proceeds revert to the diocese.

### Bequests, Charitable Remainder Trusts, and Revocable Planned Gifts

While we will commemorate and record bequests, Charitable Remainder Trusts and other revocable planned gifts made to the diocese, they cannot be included in the campaign total precisely because of their revocable nature. Unrestricted bequests received during the course of the campaign may be counted towards the campaign at the diocese's discretion.

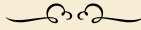
